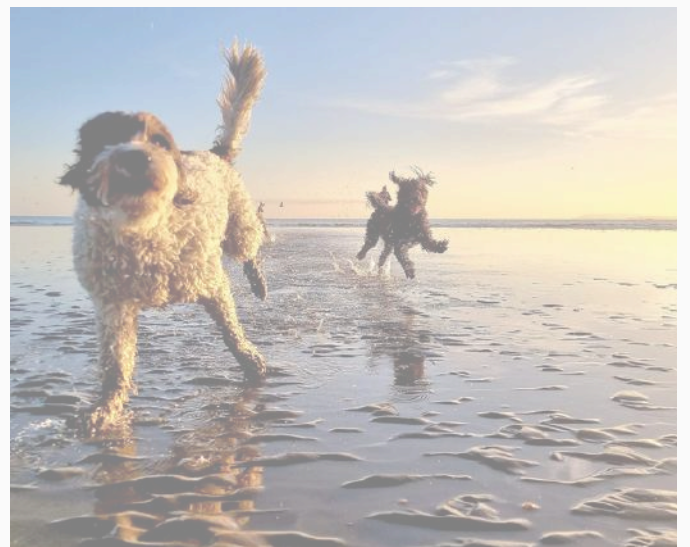


THE LIFEGUARDS ARE BACK
